
No Objection Certificate

ORDER

The Pharmacy Council of India, the Statutory body governing the Pharmacy Education in India have decided to upgrade the minimum registrable qualification from D.Pharm to B.Pharm. Kerala State Self Financing B.Pharm college Management Association and D.Pharm holders have been requesting for approval of Lateral Entry scheme for D.Pharm holders in to II year B.Pharm Course for quite sometime.

Government examined the matter in detail in consultation with the Director of Medical Education and decided to implement the scheme of Lateral Entry in Pharmacy Education so that it will enable the D.Pharm holders to upgrade their qualification. The Lateral Entry scheme will be implemented in all the Government as well as Self Financing Pharmacy Colleges from the Academic year 2005-06 subject to the following conditions.

1. Admission through lateral entry will be made from a rank list prepared on the basis of a Common Entrance Examination conducted by the Director of Medical Education for D.Pharm holders. Candidates who have passed D.Pharm examination with a minimum of 50% marks from an institution recognized by AICTE/ Pharmacy Council of India will be eligible to attend the Entrance examination conducted by the Director of Medical Education. For SC/ST candidates minimum eligible mark will be 45% in the qualifying examination (D.Pharm)
2. Allotment of candidates will be based on their rank in the list prepared by the Director of Medical Education and also on the basis of the option of the candidates.

institutions from the existing rank list. The fee at the rate fixed by Government shall be levied from the candidates allotted by the Commissioner of Entrance Examinations against merit quota.
