Phytochemical constituents from herbal plants play a vital role in maintaining the brain's chemical balance by controlling the function of receptors for the major inhibitory neurotransmitters. In traditional practice of medicine, herbal plants have been reported to treat neuro-disorders. In this scenario, it is essential to determine through herbal research approach the magnitude and pattern of neuro-disorders in India to facilitate planning and arranging health needs at the local, regional and national levels of health care delivery system with required human resources, development of infrastructure, to provide available and reasonable medical care. Therefore, there is a pressing necessity for better treatment in order to lighten the social and financial burden of neurological diseases.

This seminar will provide knowledge on advances in understanding the triggers of neurodegenerative disease, current herbal therapies for neurodegenerative diseases, major barrier in the development of novel herbal formulations and its challenges against neuro-disorders.
