1. Introduction

SJCOPS receives PG student project financial assistance from

Kerala State Council for Science, Technology & Environment (KSCSTE), Thiruvananthapuram on every year. St James Hospital and SJCOPS having Pharmacovigilance Centre and Materiovigilance Centre approved by Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission (IPC) an autonomous

II. Eligibility for Admission

a. For M.Pharm Course

Candidates must be citizens of India. A candidate who has passed the B. Pharm degree examination from Kerala University of Health Sciences or an examination equivalent to of any other universities recognized by Kerala University of Health Sciences with not less than a total of 50% marks for the B.Pharm degree examination shall be eligible for admission to M. Pharm degree course. The candidate should have undergone B. Pharm degree course in an institution approved by PCI.

b. For Pharm. D PB

Candidates must be citizens of India. A candidate who has passed the B.Pharm degree examination of Kerala University Of Health Sciences or an examination equivalent thereto of any other University recognized by the Kerala University of Health Sciences with not less than a total of 50% Marks for B.Pharm Degree examination shall be eligible for admission to Pharm.D. (PB) course.

The candidate should have undergone B.Pharm in an institution approved by the PCI. Candidates who have passed their B.Pharm course from Universities outside Kerala will be eligible for admission only if their qualifying examination is recognized by the Kerala University of Health Sciences, on the date of application/allotment. The candidate shall fulfill eligibility before last date of application.

A continuation affiliation order from Pharmacy council of India (PCI) and Kerala University of Health Sciences are awaited. Taking into account the likelihood of delay in completing the admission process, this prospectus is issued subject to the condition that appropriate modifications will be made on receipt of necessary order from the institution concerned, regarding affiliation.

HOW TO APPLY

Candidates shall apply online through the link available in the college website www.stjamespharmacycollege.in. Application fee of Rs 1000 can be remitted online. A hard copy of the application along with the copy of the qualifying examination mark list, copy of age proof should be submitted to the college before the last date.

Submission of Application form:

Certificates in respect of the community/minority quota category students shall be obtained from the revenue authorities as per the directions contained in the judgment of the Hon'ble High Court and the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Filled application form together with all the required documents should reach the concerned college on or before the stipulated time

List of copies of following self attested certificates/ documents to be submitted along with the application:

1. 12th/ 10th certificate in proof of the date of birth (Copy of SSLC or equivalent).
2. Mark list of qualifying examination
3. GPAT Score Card
4. Caste / Community certificate and Income Certificate to prove eligibility for reservation in the case of eligible candidates.
5. Candidates who have passed their B.Pharm course from universities outside Kerala must attach the Equivalency / Eligibility Certificate.

Note:

1. Applications received late will not be accepted.
2. Incomplete Applications will be rejected.
3. Candidates should not enclose any original certificate along with the application.

PUBLICATION OF RANK LIST:

A common rank list separate for M.Pharm and Pharm.D (PB) of all the candidates eligible for admission will be published on the college website

- M.Pharm: In case of tie, considering the specialization in M.Pharm, applied for, the percentage of marks obtained in the specific subject of the final year B. Pharm will be added to the total percentage of marks (Percentage aggregate of IInd, IIIrd and IVth Year B.Pharm) , so as to calculate the rank. Eg:- If more than one student who have applied for M.Pharm Pharmaceutical Chemistry gets same percentage for B.Pharm, the percentage of marks for Pharmaceutical Chemistry in final B.Pharm will be added to the total percentage of marks to calculate the rank. If a tie still exists, the age of the candidate will be taken into account. The elder will be preferred to the younger.
- PharmD. (PB): In case of tie, the percentage of marks obtained in the final year B. Pharm will be added to the total percentage of marks (Percentage aggregate of IInd, IIIrd and IVth Year B.Pharm), so as to calculate the rank. If a tie still exists, the age of the candidate will be taken into account. The elder will be preferred to the younger.
- Furnishing false information/ particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course and in addition, it will attract the relevant provisions of Criminal law of the land.
- Seats lying vacant after the date fixed for the completion of admission will be treated as lapsed seats and can be filled up by college from among the application received from the eligible candidates.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Selected candidates shall take admission at the appointed time and date in the college after paying the Tuition fee, Caution Deposit and Special fee etc. failing which, the offer of admission

will be cancelled.

2. Originals of all certificates / documents enclosed with the application should be submitted at the time of admission to the respective colleges.
3. Physical Fitness Certificate, Equivalency Certificate, Migration Certificate, Conduct Certificate and Transfer Certificate etc in original should be submitted at the time of admission to the respective colleges

Collection of tuition fee, special fee etc. should be as prescribed by the Fee Regulatory Committee (FRC). Pending issue of orders regulating fee by the FRC, the College is allowed to charge, provisionally the tuition fee and other fees applicable to similarly situated colleges. Levy and receipt of fee on provisional basis is subject to modification depending on the fee regulated by the FRC.

Mode of payment:

Fees can be paid by online mode (NEFT,RTGS) or by DD taken in favour of “Director, St. James college of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Chalakudy”, payable at Chalakudy. “In the case of SC/ST candidates, their liability to pay fees shall be governed by the Orders issued from time to time issued by the Central and the State Governments and those of SC/ST Departments. No fees will be collected from SC/ST students or other eligible candidates except in accordance with the orders of the Central or the State Government.”

Discontinuation of course and payment of liquidated damages

College is not entitled to retain the first year tuition and other fees, except the Admission fee, if the student discontinues the course before the last date of closing of admission stipulated by the competent authorities.

“Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the Pharmacy College before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the 1st year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the College at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the College midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent “Civil Court”

Code of Conduct

Every student is required to adhere strictly to the code of conduct of the institution.

Caution: Prohibition of Ragging

Ragging/ any type of misconduct towards any students either in the college campus or outside will be considered as a criminal offence and will be immediately reported to the police. Perpetrators will not be permitted to continue their study. Every student shall at the time of admission furnish a character certificate from the institute where from he/ she has passed the qualifying examination/the course last attended. Such a certificate should mention the status of his /her behavioral pattern especially in terms as to whether he/she had displayed persistent violent or aggressive behavior or any desire to harm others.
