Memorandum Of understanding (MOU)

Memorandum of understanding was signed between Rotary Club Chalakudy South, District-3201, Club No.80892 represented by the president, Mr.M. S Dileep and St James' College of Pharmaceutical Sciences, River Bank, Chalakudy, represented by Dr. K Krishnakumar, the college principal,

Both parties named above agreed to abide by the terms and conditions detailed below under which the college and the NGO will work together.

1. College students, N.S.S. volunteers, and U.B. A. volunteers from the college, accompanied by faculty members, will participate in the welfare programmes organized by the NGO.
2. The NGO will assist the college students in conducting welfare activities in a particular underdeveloped area, village, or panchayat that is adopted by the college. Members of the N.G.O. will always accompany the college students.
3. Programmes to be undertaken will always be need-based. Such program chalked out by the N.G.O. will be finalized only after consultation with the college representative, N.S.S. programme officer, U.B.A. coordinator, faculty members, or any other delegate recommended by the principal.
4. A written approval from the principal will be forwarded to the NGO, after which students will join the programme.

5. Community welfare programmes of the following nature, when organized by the NGO, will include students from the college.
 - A. A health checkup is to be conducted by a qualified doctor with the assistance of technicians. Students will undergo an orientation programme by the NGO before joining such events.
 - B. Nutrition and health education:
 - I. Demonstration of low-cost, nutritious food
 - II. Personal hygiene
 - III. Vaccination
 - IV. Dos and don'ts for expectant and nursing mothers
 - V. Care of people with common health problems like high blood pressure. Diabetes. Obesity, abnormally low body weight, deficiency diseases, and many more occasions
 - C. Income-generating programs: College students and NGO members may jointly conduct training programs for community women and girls. Thus, prepare them for
 - D. Adult and functional literacy among women: necessary teaching materials are available with the N.G.O.
 - E. Environmental sanitation: Students and N.G.O. members will jointly approach civic authorities in adopted areas if a lack of civic amenities is detected during the survey.
6. The N.G.O. will inform the college principal about the commencement of any of the above programmes well in advance so that the students get enough time for preparation. The date of commencement, details of the program and those of the program site, duration of the program, etc. will be communicated.
7. Obtaining permission from the guardianship of the students will be the responsibility of the college.
8. A safe and comfortable journey to and from the programme site will be the responsibility of the college.
9. Any financial liability regarding the collaborative activities should be discussed by both parties well in advance.
10. This MOU shall be in force from the date herein mentioned above, and either party can terminate the MOU with one-month prior written notice to the other party.

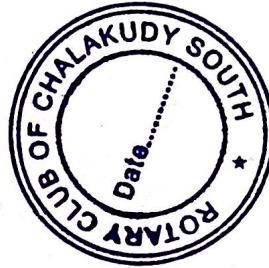


