Memorandum Of understanding (MOU)

Memorandum of understanding was signed between St James College of Pharmaceutical Sciences, River Bank, Chalakudy, represented by Dr. K. Krishnakumar, (The principal, St James College of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Chalakudy) and Pariyaram Gramapanchayath (ward 10) represented by Smt. Maya N.S, (President, Pariyaram Grama Panchayath)

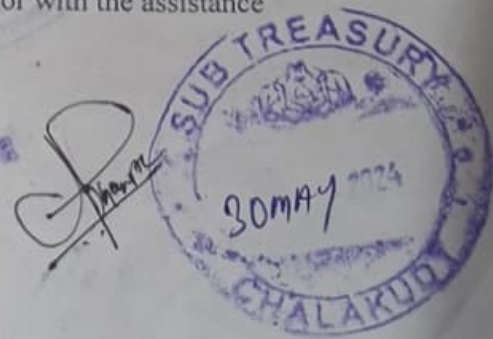
Both parties named above agreed to abide by the terms and conditions detailed below under which the college and the grama panchayat will work together.

1. N.S.S. volunteers from the college NSS unit, accompanied by faculty members, will participate in the welfare programmes organized by the NGO.
2. Grama panchayat president and Ward Member of ward 10 will assist in conducting welfare activities in a particular underdeveloped area of panchayat that is adopted by the college.
3. Programmes to be undertaken will always be need-based. Such program chalked out by the panchayat will be finalized only after consultation with the N.S.S. programme officer or any other delegate recommended by the principal.
4. A written approval from the principal will be forwarded to the grama panchayat, after which students will join the programme.
5. Community welfare programmes of the following nature, when organized by the grama panchayat, will include NSS volunteers from the college.
 - A. A health checkup is to be conducted by a qualified doctor with the assistance of technician.
 - B. Nutrition and health education:
 - I. Demonstration of low-cost, nutritious food
 - II. Personal hygiene

- III. Care of people with common health problems like high blood pressure, Diabetes, Obesity, abnormally low body weight, deficiency diseases, and many more occasions
 - C. Environmental programmes -planting trees (Sneharamam projects), awareness programmes.
 - D. Environmental sanitation: Students and N.G.O. members will jointly approach civic authorities in adopted areas if a lack of civic amenities is detected during the survey.
 - E. Conducting 7 days NSS Special camp including health camps, surveys, sanitation programmes, awareness programmes
6. Grama panchayat will inform the college principal about the commencement of any of the above programmes well in advance so that the students get enough time for preparation. The date of commencement, details of the program and those of the program site, duration of the program, etc. will be communicated.
 7. Obtaining permission from the guardianship of the students will be the responsibility of the college.
 8. A safe and comfortable journey to and from the programme site will be the responsibility of the college.
 9. Any financial liability regarding the collaborative activities should be discussed by both parties well in advance.
 10. This MOU shall be in force from the date herein mentioned above, and either party can terminate the MOU with one-month prior written notice to the other party.
